Vintage

The 2016 vintage in the Southern Rhone valley is exceptional, both in terms of quality and quantity. This vintage is generous in colour, generous in structure and in ripeness

The estate

Christine and Daniel CHAUSSY, brother and sister are the 5th generation to lead Mas de Boislauzon. The domaine, located on Orange, in the north of the appellation Chateauneuf-du-Pape, takes 10 hectares in Chateauneuf-du-Pape and 20 hectares in Côtes du Rhône Villages. All vines are in organic farming since 2012.

Vineyard

Vines are grown in clay soils, covered with rolled pebbles.

Vinification

The harvest are done by hand with very fussy bunch-sorting. It's 100% destemmed. No yeast added. It's a traditional vinification with temperature control. This wine is fermented and aged in new barrels.

70% Roussanne ; 30% Grenache
