Vintage

The 2016 vintage in the Southern Rhone valley is exceptional, both in terms of quality and quantity. This vintage is generous in colour, in structure and in ripeness.

Estate

Christine and Daniel CHAUSSY, brother and sister, are the 5th generation to lead Mas de Boislauzon. The domaine, located in Orange, in the north of the appellation Chateauneuf-du-Pape, covers 10 hectares in Chateauneuf-du-Pape and 20 hectares in Côtes du Rhône Villages. All vines have been organically farmed since 2012.

Vineyard

Vines are grown in clay soils, covered with rounded pebbles.

Vinification

The harvest is hand-picked, meticulously sorted and 100% destemmed. It's a traditional vinification with temperature control. No yeast added. This wine is aged in a barrels and tank.

Grape varieties

70% Grenache; 30% Mourvèdre

Tasting

This wine is a powerful wine, balanced, silky tannins and a beautiful length in the mouth.

Service

It's enjoyed with grilled meat, a spicy dish, cheese... Serving temperature 18°.
