The estate

Christine and Daniel CHAUSSY, brother and sister, are the 5th generation to lead Mas de Boislauzon. Today, the sixth has joined them. The domaine, located in Orange, in the north of the appellation Châteauneuf-du-Pape, covers 11 acres of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, 19 acres in Côtes du Rhône Villages and 2 acres in Vin de France. All vines have been organically farmed since 2012.

Grape varieties

70% Grenache; 30% Mourvèdre

Vineyard

Vines are grown in clay soils, covered with rounded pebbles.

Area

Boislauzon, la Gardiole, Palestor et Brusquières.

Vinification

The harvest is hand-picked, meticulously sorted and 100% destemmed. It's a traditional vinification with temperature control. No yeast added. This wine is aged in barrels and tank.

Tasting

This wine is a powerful wine, balanced, silky tannins and a beautiful length in the mouth.

It's enjoyed with grilled meat, a spicy dish, cheese...
